Year 12 Geography Field Trip to the Lincolnshire Coast Tuesday 3rd March 2015

As part of the AS geography course we wish to carry out a coastal landforms trip along the Lincolnshire coast examining Coastal Management at Skegness, Sand Dunes and Salt marshes and Managed Retreat at Frieston.
