- Following my appointment as the Science Link Governor HH, Curriculum Science Leader invited me to visit
- The meeting was scheduled for one hour but due to a parent call was about 45 minutes.
- The objectives of the meeting were for me to meet HH, see the facilities and get a feel for the Department.
- HH came across as a very hard working and committed teacher/department head who wants the
 best possible outcomes for her pupils. She has a background in industry which allows her to relate
 the theoretical to the practical.
- Following an initial chat she gave me a tour of the Department and took me through some of the premises issues she faces as well as informing about current topics and projects being studied.
- Due to time constraints on the evening a follow up visit is necessary to fully understand the performance of the Department and its plans for improvement
- HH has given me a copy of her Faculty Improvement Plan and I will arrange a follow up meeting with her to discuss this in detail and will report back to governors. Like a lot of internal documents it contains plenty of jargon and abbreviations which are a mystery to me.

Any key issues arising for the governing body

e.g. The way resources are allocated, the way the school communicates, progress in implementing a key policy

- The central outside area outside that you pass on the way to Science had some loose slabs that need to be stabilised in order for them not to be a health and safety issue.
- The facilities are unappealing, out of date and require significant investment particularly the external classrooms. I understand the internal college maintenance staff try hard to keep on top of the maintenance but a significant investment is required to bring it up to the 21st century.
- With our own lack of funds I would be keen to understand how we obtain investment to improve an ageing facility.
- However, whilst I am sure there is a connection with facilities, it is ultimately the results that count and my next visit will delve further into the Department's performance and plans.
